

## Bingo Call Sheet

Instructions:

After giving each student a Bingo sheet, choose and read a description. Kids shout out what they believe the answer is. Confirm the answer is correct, then kids mark their cards. The first student to complete a row (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal) shouts "Bingo". Teacher confirms they are correct and that student wins that round.

	A wetland that accumulates peat	Bogland
	Yellow/orange flowers good for skin injuries	Calendula flowers
	Sea cliffs on the southwestern edge of the Burren, with a height of 702'	Cliffs of Moher
	Starts life as tadpole, one of only six reptiles in Ireland	Common Frog
	Water bird with ornate head plumes, carry young on their backs	Crested Grebe
	Purple flower deemed sacred by the faeries	Cuckooflower
	Type of brown trout native to Lough Neagh, returns to the rivers to spawn	Dollagan
	Hexagon basalt columns in Ireland	Giants Causeway
	A large area of dense ice moving under its own weight	Glacier
	Known as the tree of knowledge in Ireland	Hazel Tree
	Rocks made from cooling magma	Igneous rocks
	The largest deer to live, extinct for over 6000 years	Irish Elk
	Small ground cover plant with white flowers used to treat inflammation	Irish Eyebright
	Bright yellow flower used to treat digestive issues and stop bleeding	Loosestrife
	Largest lake in Ireland	Lough Neagh

	Rocks formed by heat and pressure	Metamorphic rocks
	Tallest peak in County Donegal	Mt. Errigal
	A very strong tree, used in building.	Oak Tree
	Found in wetland made up of decaying vegetation, used as fuel	Peat
	White fish only abundant in Lough Neagh	Pollan
	Pink flower with spikey/lace-like petals, used as soap	Ragged Robins
	Largest non-domesticated land mammal in Ireland	Red Deer
	The only canine mammal left in Ireland	Red Fox
	Reddish brown bird native only to the British Isles	Red Grouse
	Woodland rodent with tufted ears, spending most of their time in the tree canopy	Red Squirrel
	Longest River in Ireland	River Shannon
	This pink colored flesh fish swims from salt to fresh water in order to spawn	Salmon
	Rocks formed by layers	Sedimentary rocks
	Type of clover, national symbol of Ireland	Shamrock
	Mostly of limestone, this area in the west of Ireland has over70% of Ireland's species of flowers	The Burren
	With white wings and black spots this insect appears to have a fur mantle around its head	White ermine moth
	The largest continuous upland area in the Republic of Ireland, found in the East of the island	Wicklow Mountains
	Dog breed to hunt wolves in Ireland	Wolfhound
	Apex predator in Ireland, exterminated 200 years ago	Wolves
	With very long life spans, this tree is associated with longevity	Yew Tree
