



# Bingo Call Sheet

Instructions: After giving each student a Bingo sheet, choose and read a description. Kids shout out what they believe the answer is. Confirm the answer is correct, then kids mark their cards. The first student to complete a row (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal) shouts "Bingo". Teacher confirms they are correct and that student wins that round.

<input type="checkbox"/>	This pink colored flesh fish swims from salt to fresh water in order to spawn	Salmon

<input type="checkbox"/>	Type of clover, national symbol of Ireland	Shamrock
<input type="checkbox"/>	Mostly of limestone, this area in the west of Ireland has over 70% of Ireland's species of flowers	The Burren

<input type="checkbox"/>	The largest continuous upland area in the Republic of Ireland, found in the East of the island	Wicklow Mountains
