Very long life spans, this tree is associated with longevity

A very strong tree, used in building.

Type of orchid with white flowers growing in a spiral around a straight stalk

Small ground cover plant with white flowers used to treat inflammation

Yellow/orange flowers good for skin injuries

Bright yellow flower used to treat digestive issues and stop bleeding

Small white flower used as painkiller (aspirin)

Purple flower deemed sacred by the faeries

Type of wood shillelaghs are made out of

Pink flower with spikey/lace-like petals, used as soap

Longest River in Ireland

The largest continuous upland area in the Republic of Ireland, found in the East of the island

Largest lake in Ireland

A wetland that accumulates peat

Found in wetland made up of decaying vegetation, used as fuel

Hexagon basalt columns in Ireland

Rock made from cooling magma

Rock formed by heat and pressure

Rock formed by layers

Tallest peak in County Donegal

Mostly of limestone, this area in the West of Ireland has over 70% of Ireland's species of flowers

Sea cliffs on the southwestern edge of the Burren, with a height of 702'

A large area of dense ice moving under its own weight

Dog breed to hunt wolves in Ireland

The only canine mammal left in Ireland

Reddish brown bird native only to the British Isles

Starts life as tadpole, one of only six reptiles in Ireland

Woodland rodent with tufted ears, spending most of their time in the tree canopy

Black and white, nocturnal burrowing carnivore found in Ireland

Water bird with ornate head plumes, carry young on their backs

Apex predator in Ireland, exterminated 200 years ago

The largest deer to live, extinct for over 6000 years

largest non-domesticated land mammal in Ireland

White wings and black spots this insect appears to have a fur mantle around its head

This pink colored flesh fish swims from salt to fresh water in order to spawn

White fish only abundant in Lough Neagh

Type of brown trout native to Lough Neagh, returns to the rivers to
