Type of clover, national symbol of Ireland Known as the tree of knowledge in Ireland the tree known for strength and healing in Ireland The tree symbolizing the balance between male & female Very long life spans, this tree is associated with longevity A very strong tree, used in building. Type of orchid with white flowers growing in a spiral around a straight stalk Small ground cover plant with white flowers used to treat inflammation Yellow/orange flowers good for skin injuries Bright yellow flower used to treat digestive issues and stop bleeding Small white flower used as painkiller (aspirin)
