Welcome the audience to the show and invite the audience to join the class in a journey of Irish Dance

Begin with the Druids/Celts: Scene - outdoors possibly with a stone circle or Celtic Hut in the background

Students act out narration

Travelling dance teachers: Scene - indoors

Have teacher instructing dancers/actors

Meeting at the Crossroads: Scene outside with two roads connecting

Have dancers/actors come out and do some dancing

Doors Laid Down

Have dancers dance on the "door"
