

Giants Causeway Info

Over 40,000 basalt columns make up Giant's Causeway

Tallest columns are 82 ' high at the cliffs, closer to the ocean the highest are 39 '

Diameters of columns between 15-20 inches

Most of the columns have between 5-7 irregular sides

Formed $^{\sim}$ 50-60 million years ago from lava Pressure between columns along with cooling and cracking created polygonal shapes

Designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1986

Declaried a national nature reserve in 1987 by the Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland

Located in Northern Ireland, County Antrim on the north coast

Over 1 million people visited Giant's Causeway in 2017
