... to be raised in secret by a woman warrior and a woman druid in what is today known as the Slieve Bloom mountains.

Mother sits down.

From the warrior he learned weaponry and battle and from the druid he learned wisdom and strength.

When Fionn grew up he studied with a poet and druid named Finnegas choose a boy to be Finnegas; stand at the front of the room Fionn walks to him, girls sit down.

Finnegas lived by the River Boyne and spent many years trying to catch the Salmon of Knowledge, believed to hold all the knowledge in the world.

When the faery prince lulled the people to sleep

Plays music

Fionn kept pricking himself with his spear to stay awake.

When the faery prince had put everyone to sleep, he stopped playing his music to burn the roofs, but Fionn was there and killed him.

faery prince sits down

Dawn broke and everyone woke up...

Class wakes up; Choose a boy to be king stand at the side of the room.

Fionn walks over to king

The king was very happy and made Fionn the commander of the Fianna.
