Ardcroney Church	All villages had a church that served the local community
Blacksmith Forge	
Weaver's Shed	Outbuilding (separate from the home), holds the loom
School House	Holds up to 80 people
Doctor's	The front parlor of the home was used to treat patients
Artisan House	Potters wheel
Brown's Pawnbrocker	An important part of local economy
JJ Corry's Pub	Community gathering place; The family kitchen could be used by people known to them
Sean O'Farrell's Drapery	Sold Irish linen, poplin and woollens; owners lived upstairs
Foster's Printworks	printed pamphlets, handbills, notices, newspappers; All type was set by hand
Cahill's Grocery	Began selling foodstuffs that previously were only home produced; imported foods as well
McInernry & Sons, Hardware	in the late 19th century (1800's) tools and utensils began to be available Replacing what was made by local craftworkers
Post Office	Founded at the end of the 19th century
P Macnarmar & Son Bar/Hotel	At the turn of the century people began to travel more; A hotel was needed
