Groomsman	Took care of the horses and stables
The Nanny	Took care of the infants and children still in the nursery
The Governess	Taught and minded the lordships' school age children
Lady's Companion	Some ladies had paid companions for company

Guard	Over the soldiers of the castle
The Guard	Soldiers who protected the castle
The Priest	Conducted services, weddings, christenings, etc.
