

## Celtic Hut Construction

## Adjust building materials as appropriate




Step One: Place a peg in the middle of the building space.

Using a rope the radius of the circle, draw a circle

around the peg.

Remember to create a place for the entrance.

Step Two: Dig out the wall gulley.



Step Three: Place oak stakes into the gulley, leaving room for

the entrance.

Step Four: Weave hazel "wattle" (long thin pieces of wood)

between the stakes like a basket.

Step Five: Cut holes in thin oak stakes and place over upright

stakes to create a wall plate.



Step Six: Raise a pole in the middle of the circle.

Step Seven: Attach principle rafters to pole and wall plates.



Step Eight: Place two wood "rings connecting the rafters.

Add in "spokes" to rings for strength.

Add thin rods across rafters to attach thatch to.

Step Nine: Add thatch over the rafter and attach to thin rods.



Step Ten: Mix clay, cow dung, straw, and water to create

"daub". Push mixture into the walls in between

the wattle and smooth.
