



Art Gallery

Curator (the teacher)

<u>Determine the theme</u> of the show (consider having students vote).

Examples:

- Plants and Animals of Ireland
- Irish Legends
- Ancient Irish Places

- Historical Ireland
- St Patrick's Day
- Invasions

Decide on number of art pieces and sizes

Determine art media (can be multiple):

Pen/Pencil Colored Pencil Watercolor Pastels Digital to print Other Crayons

Determine gallery space parameters/location

<u>Provide information to the teams</u> - Handouts are prepared for each team.

Teams (see detailed team instructions in student handouts):

Artists - Create, title, and sign the work.

Gallery Design Team - Design and creates the space where the artwork will be exhibited. What do the walls look like? What is the color scheme? How are the titles displayed? What does the Title Wall look like (create the title wall)? Map out the dimensions of the exhibit space, accounting for the number and size of finished pieces.

Copy Writing/Labels Team - Creates the copy (writing) for each art piece and along with labels and the copy for the catalog.

Marketing Team - Create the flyer and the catalog for the gallery.
