Art Exhibit

The online art exhibit is the basis for the education module. Students need to view the exhibit, look at the artwork, and either listen to or read the narrative for each work. This is a virtual experience and students can "walk" around the exhibit at their own pace, or take a tour.

Activities Guide

The Activities guide enhances the learning experience beyond the art exhibit. There are two categories of activities: Individual & Group/Class.

Activities have been created in such a way to touch on all different learning aspects and have corresponding icons to show what areas are covered by each activity:



There are two **icons** in the Activity Guide showing supplemental material:



= There is a corresponding hand out to give the students as a part of the activity.



= There is supplemental information for the teacher to use/reference for the activity.

Time to complete activities ranges from twenty minutes (such as the Follow Along - done in conjunction with viewing the art exhibit), to several days/weeks. The teacher decides which activities to assign the class, if any.

Supplemental Material

Some activities need additional information in order to complete. The supplemental material offers information not included in the activities guide to both enhance the educational experience for the student and give additional information to the teacher. Some of the teacher supplementals are informative while others are the answers to the student work.

All supplementals are digital pdfs and links can be copied and sent to students without them getting access to the website and therefore the answers.
