8.	Torc Mountain, meaning "wild <u>boar</u> " in Irish, was the home of the						
	Beaker folk, who were <u>copper</u> miners. In 1932 the land was						
	donated and became the first <u>national</u> <u>park</u> in Ireland.						
9.	Torc Cascades is a waterfall with a legend for its beginning. A man, cursed by the						
	devil, turned into a <u>boar</u> every night. One day a farmer figured out his secret,						
	and the boar burst into <u>flames</u> . He threw himself into <u>Devil's</u>						
	Punchbowl lough and the water overflowed creating the waterfall and covering						
	the boar's cave.
